



What is the Pituitary Gland?

The pituitary is a hormone-producing gland, situated behind the bridge of the nose and below the base of the brain.

If you have been diagnosed as having a pituitary disorder such as Acromegaly, Craniopharyngioma, Cushing's, Diabetes Insipidus, Hypogonadism, Prolactinoma or Pituitary Adenoma you should contact The Pituitary Foundation.

Symptoms: can include fatigue, headaches, weight changes, poor body temperature control, extreme thirst, infertility, mood changes.
